

2009-2010 MFSC Membership Policies

Membership Year

The Membership year runs from July 1st through June 30th of the following year.

Adult & Junior MFSC Membership:

MFSC Membership (Adult & Junior) includes registration with United States Figure Skating (USFS), a family subscription to "Skating Magazine", MFSC ice privileges for skaters, and eligibility to test and compete within the USFS structure.

- Dues are \$165 per year for the first skating member in a family, and 50% of that amount, or \$82.50, for the 2nd member in the family. Third or more family members will pay a fee of \$50 each.
- Dues are reduced to \$75 per year for skaters who are first-time members and are either recent MFSC Basic Skills graduates or are currently enrolled in the Basics Skills program at level 6 or higher.

Associate MFSC Membership

Associate MFSC Membership is available for skaters who are registered by another USFS Club as their Home Club and represent that Club at competitions. Such members will have access to MFSC ice sessions.

- Dues are \$100 per membership year
- These members will be required to sign a Waiver for insurance purposes (recommended by USFS's insurer to cover them on MFSC ice).
- They may test at MFSC test sessions without paying the additional fee charged to non-Club testers.

Voting Membership

Voting memberships may be purchased by those non-skating adults who wish to vote on Club matters and be eligible to hold office or serve as a delegate. These members will be registered with the USFS.

- Dues are \$75 per year.

MFSC Coaches

MFSC Coaches are required to be Club members, and as such are granted all ice privileges.

- Dues are \$40 per year.
- A MFSC Coach whose home club is not MFSC is an Associate Member.

Honorary Members

Honorary Members are elected to this status by the board and are usually adults.

- Dues are complimentary for Honorary members.
- These members are registered with USFS, naming MFSC as their Home club.
- They will continue to receive Club communications and will be considered active as long as they return their USFS Registration forms.

- Honorary status is terminated when registration forms are not returned or the term of status as elected by the Board is completed.

MFSC Board Members

MFSC Board Members are required to be USFS and MFSC members as part of their eligibility for service on the MFSC Board.

- Board members shall carry either an ADULT or VOTING membership.

GENERAL RULES

- Ice use eligibility Only Adult, Junior and Associate MFSC Members may register for “Club” ice sessions. This policy is suspended during summer skating school. As the sponsor of the event, MFSC liability insurance is in force.
- Basic Skills skaters may join MFSC at any time by paying the MFSC membership dues as described above. MFSC membership makes them eligible to use “Club” (for extra ice time or lessons). They may continue to register for Basic Skills programs by paying the group lesson fee. Some restrictions on Club ice will apply to low-skill skaters, at the discretion of the Ice Committee.
- Students, who were MFSC members prior to moving for educational purposes, may skate during academic breaks without paying a membership fee. They must, however, sign a Waiver of Liability and pay current drop-in fees to skate on MFSC ice sessions.
- Summer School, Summer school skaters are not required to be members of the MFSC but must be current USFS/ISI members.
