The classes are taught by our qualified MFSC staff of instructors

The 50 minute session includes 25 minutes of group instruction and 25 minutes of “free time” for practicing or private lessons. Parents should request lessons directly from the coach of their choice. The 25-minute Little STARS session includes only the group class.

The program includes formal assessment and feedback to skaters as they progress through the basic skill levels outlined by United Skates Figure Skating (USFS). Each skater registered for the first time should receive a packet including badges and a booklet explaining Basic Skills.

The Little STARS: Snow Plow Sam class is a USFS program designed for young beginning skaters. Instructors direct on-ice play activities which promote coordination, strength, and beginning skating skills.

The Hockey STARS: Learn to Skate class is a USFS program providing instruction on the fundamentals of hockey skating. Skating elements are taught WITHOUT hockey gear -- no sticks or pucks. Proper skating techniques are emphasized promoting speed and agility on the ice. Hockey STARS students must be 8 years old and/or a graduate of the Little STARS: Snow Plow Sam program

The STARS: Basic Skills class is an expanded version of the USFS Basic Skills program. Skaters progress through 8 skill levels. Beginning skaters start with instruction on basic skating techniques for forward and backward movement, stopping, and turning, and progress through advanced levels where they learn advanced elements such as spins and jumps.
