

MFSC Fundraising/Volunteer Information

Fundraising

As a result of increased ice fees and fewer skaters, the MFSC (with a unanimous board vote) has instituted a mandatory fundraising requirement per member family for \$100 profit for the 2010-2011 membership year. The Fundraising Committee will create opportunities to help families meet this goal. However, if a family chooses not to participate in fundraising, a \$100 buyout fee can be forwarded to the Club treasurer. As soon as we get new members, increase basic skills, and sell more ice time, the board will revisit this subject for the 2011-2012 fiscal year.

Volunteering

There will also be a requirement of 10 volunteer hours for each member family as stated in the revised (4-2010) MFSC By-Laws. The 10 hours required will consist of 6 hours of general volunteer time and 4 hours of competition volunteer time. A member family may opt to pay \$100 if it chooses not to participate in the volunteer opportunities. This fee is separate and additional to the \$100 fundraising fee.

You may have already fulfilled your voluntary requirements. You are exempt from the requirements based on the following situations:

- YOU MEET WHOLE YEAR REQUIREMENT =**10 HOURS** per family for 2010-2011 if you are:
 1. MFSC Board Member
 2. MFSC Committee chair

There are currently two committee chair openings, if you want to meet the volunteer commitment this year:

1. OFFICE MANAGER, which entails office organization and maintaining office supplies
 2. ICE MONITOR CHAIRPERSON, which involves scheduling adults to monitor ice sessions and educating ice monitors
- There are also a number of ways to achieve your **6 volunteer hours** family credit for 2010/2011:
 - Ice monitor for an hour per week for a session [fall, winter, spring or summer] = 6 hours
 1. Basic Skills table monitor for a session [fall, winter, spring or summer] = 6 hours
 2. Basic Skills on-ice helper for a session [fall, winter, spring or summer] = 6 hours
 - For your 4 competition volunteer hours per family for 2010-2011:
 1. Work day of competition for 4 hours = 4 hours
 2. Work before competition [registration, goody bags, food set-up] = 4 hours
